Mobiles and portables with traffic have priority, and, need not move off frequency to handle their traffic. (Reset)

One of the reasons for this weekly net is to train operators to be able to operate as the control station during an actual emergency. If you would like to be a Net Control Operator, please let us know. When you check-in, ID with your call sign, name and location.
